- A. Roll Call. A quorum was present for Technical Committee. Chance Gallagher called the technical meeting to order.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Master Transportation Plan Presentation/ Discussion

Jim Meyer with AECOM presented both Committees with a draft Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) 2050 that is updated every 5 years. The 2050 kickoff included introductions, MTP overview, 2023 Regional Transportation survey, MTP goals, recent and future development and ended with any questions. The current 2045 MTP plan was adopted in November 2019 and the new plan is set to be adopted in November 2024.

The overview included the requirements of the plan, schedule and the MTP process. A brief overview was given of the surveys that were mailed at random to citizens in the region. Jim went over the 2024 goals and objectives, which included safety, economic vitality, regionalism, accessibility, funding, transportation/land use, environmental protection, system management and public involvement. A look into recent and future projects was reviewed, going over key themes/issues from the 2045 workshops, roadway/ freight issues, transit issues, and bicycle and pedestrian issues. This is not a finalized plan as of now but will be ready to be adopted in October or November of next year. No action needed.
